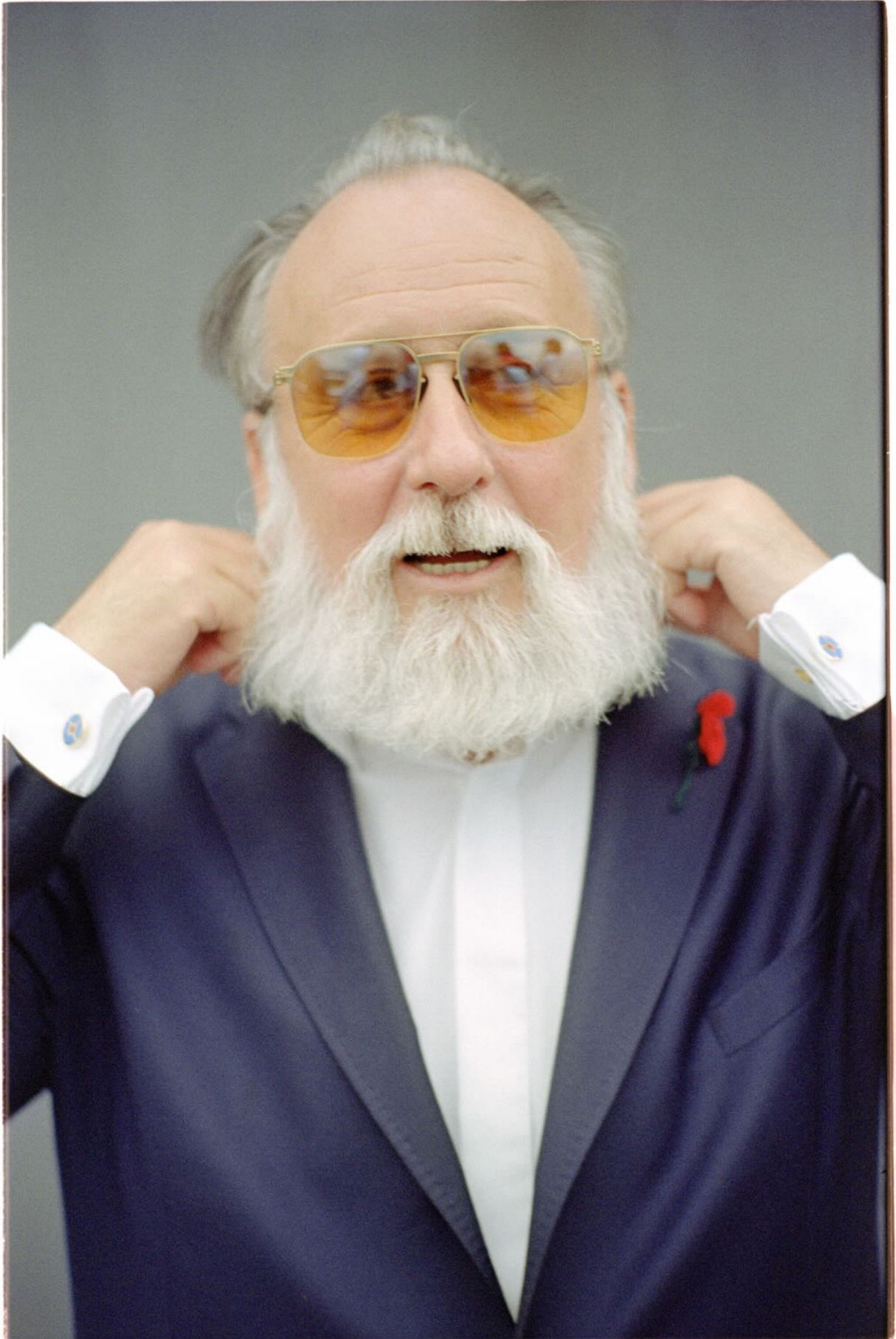

## **About the Photos:**

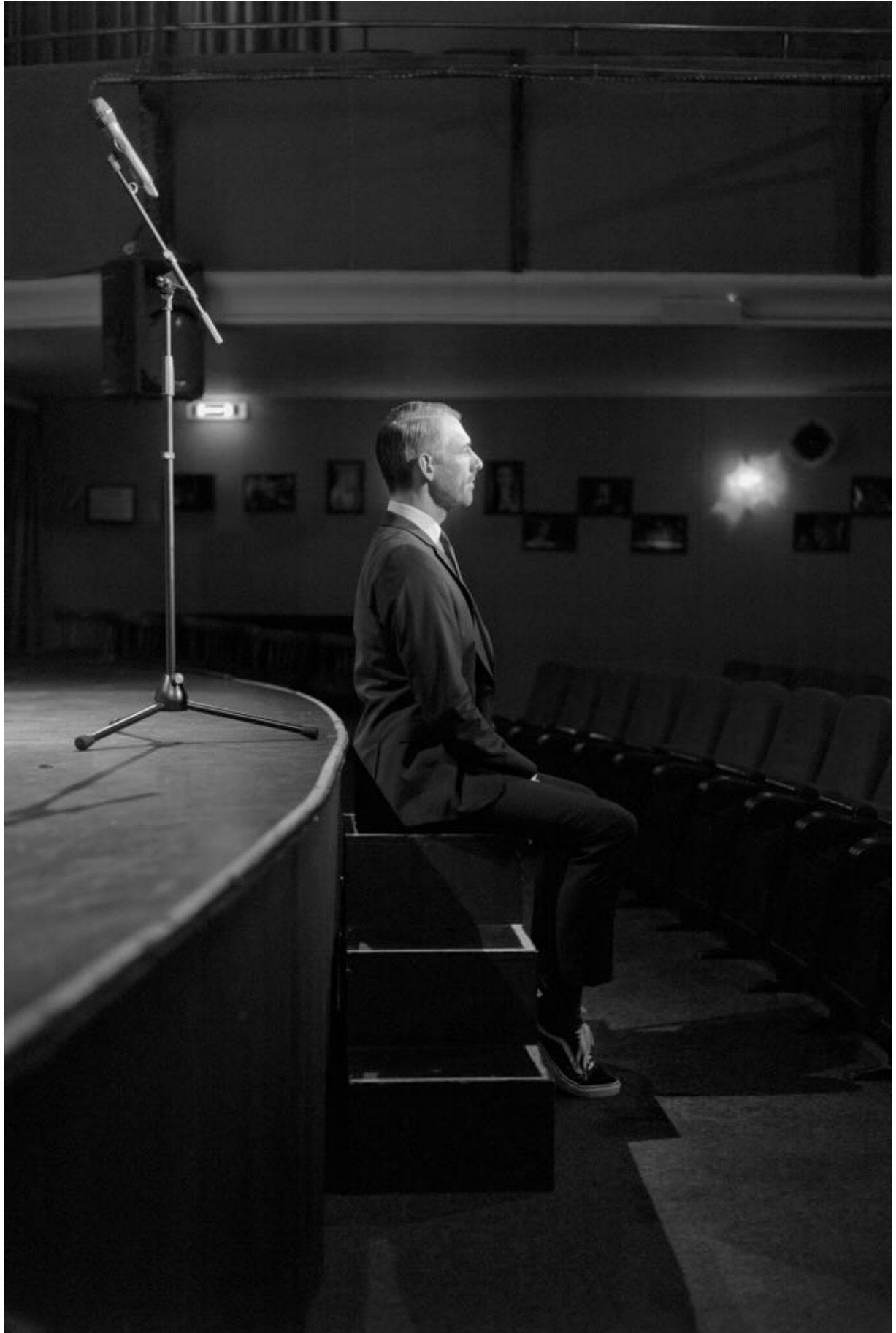

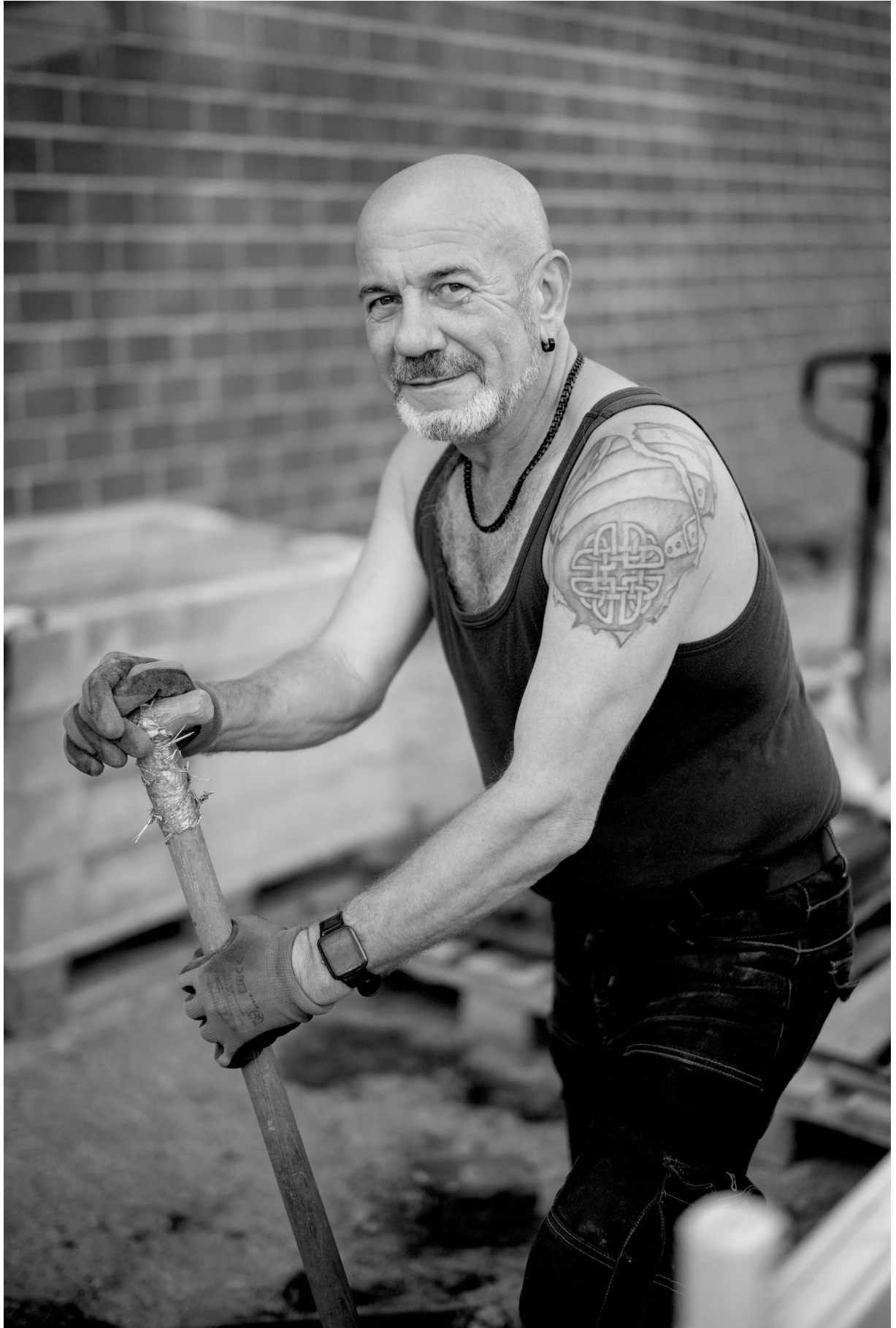

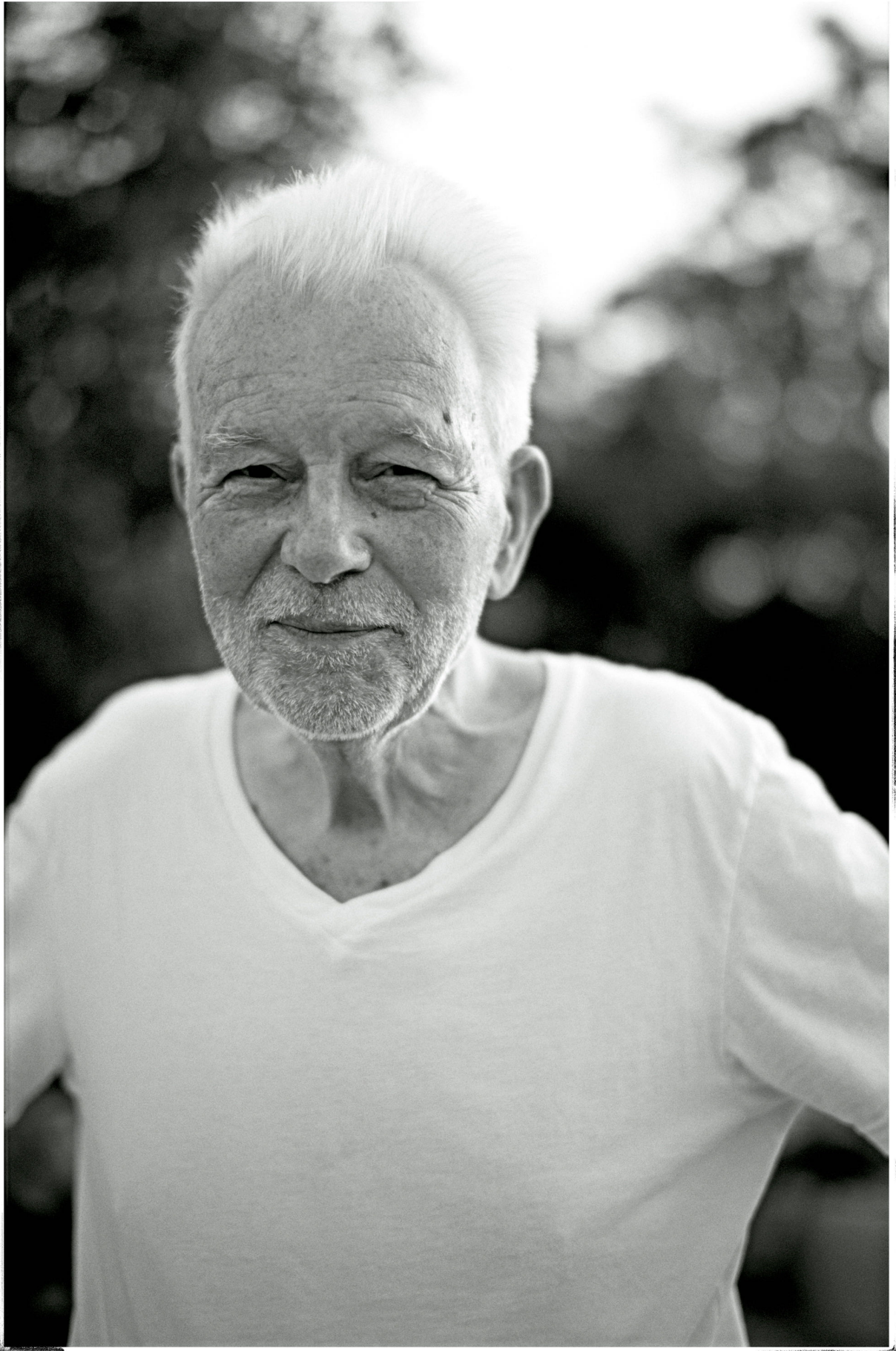
